

Pennsylvania Sporting Clays Association AED Grant Program Application (Active 2/5/25 – 2/5/26)

The AED (Automated External Defibrillator) Grant Program is designed to improve the health and safety of shooters across the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. This grant is graciously provided by the Pennsylvania Sporting Clays Association (PSCA). This is a one-time grant per club for the purchase of one AED intended to be utilized at a PSCA Club. The club applying must be a member in good standing during the year of application. The maximum grant amount is 50% of the cost of the AED purchased by the club not to exceed \$500.00. This grant will only cover the cost of the AED and items required for the device to operate only no associated accessories will be approved. Unapproved accessories will include signage, storage boxes, extra pads, extended warranties, maintenance programs and anything the PSCA Board of Directors deems unnecessary. A detailed copy of the original receipt including proof of purchase must be submitted with the application.
