

PSCA Meeting Minutes

Friday, August 26th, 2011

Location:

- Conference Call

Call to Order:

- The meeting was called to order at 7:06 PM by Ricky.

Meeting Minutes:

- The Minutes from the July (Annual State Shoot) meeting were reviewed with no issues or concerns.
- Warren motioned to accept the July Meeting Minutes. The motion was seconded by Mike with all in favor.

Treasurer's Report:

- There was no Treasurer's Report present at the meeting.

Old Business:

- **2011 State Shoot Review**
 - Below are some of the issues/concerns raised with this year's State Shoot:
 1. Nemaocolin forgetting to order event trophies.
 2. Phone calls not being returned to persons trying to get shoot information.
 3. Shooters having to write two (2) checks for entry fees and options.
 4. Options only being payable in cash (no checks).
 5. Different versions of entry forms mailed to shooters. Initial version having squadded prelim and sub-gauges and later version not having squadding for prelim and sub-gauges.
 6. \$25.00 for extra dinner tickets.
 7. Location for campers and RV's. Shooters were being advised to use Nemaocolin camp grounds at an additional cost of \$125 - \$150 per night.
 8. No representatives from Nemaocolin attended any of the monthly PSCA meeting prior to the State Shoot.
 9. Shooters having to re-register due to submitted entry forms being lost.
 10. Some of the "port-a-potties" on the course were dark and unclean.
 11. Paths too narrow for effective traffic flow.
 12. Dust on the lower course during the sub-gauge events.
 13. Shoot flyers being mailed too close to the State Shoot. (*State Shoot guideline requires that shoot flyer be mailed to shooters at least three (3) months in prior to the shoot date.*)
 14. Awkward shooting stations resulted in shooters opening their barrels into the dirt and/or rocks in front of some stations.

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15. Shoot results being mailed out three (3) weeks after the shoot. (*State Shoot guidelines require that full shoot results be mailed to all shooters within two (2) weeks of the shoot.*)
- Jeff suggested reviving the “*Shoot Buddy*” program, whereby a PSCA Board member is assigned to monitor and assist the club hosting a State or Zone Shoot. The “*shoot buddy*” will help to ensure that the hosting club is following the PSCA guidelines for Zone and State Shoots.
 - After an extensive discussion regarding whether to award Nemaocolin the entire bonus or a lesser amount, Mike motioned that Nemaocolin be awarded the full amount of \$4,000.00. The motion was seconded by Pete. A majority of those present were in favor. However, there was one (1) vote against awarding Nemaocolin the entire amount.
 - Jeff will send the bonus check to Ricky, who will draft a letter to be included with the check and forward to Nemaocolin. The letter will outline the good, as well as the discussed issues and concerns, of this year’s State Shoot.
 - Ricky informed those present that a letter was sent to the NSCA by Clyde Keller, requesting a “class review” of Randy Shirk. That request was denied by the NSCA. However, it was suggested that the PSCA could draft a “class review request” letter and re-submit it to the NSCA. After some discussion, Mike motioned that the PSCA submit a “class review request” letter to the NSCA for Randy Shirk. Seconded by Pete, with all parties in favor. Jeff also pointed out that a copy of the letter should be sent to Randy Shirk. Ricky will draft the letter and send copies to the NSCA and Randy Shirk.
 - Since the meeting was already running late, it was decided to move the budget agenda item over to the next meeting, to be held in September.

New Business:

- There was no new business.

Next Meeting date and location:

- Tentatively scheduled to be held at Blue Ridge on Friday, September 16th, 2011 @ 7:00 PM.
