

2015 PSCA Annual Meeting Minutes

Saturday July 18th, 2015

Location

- Meeting was held at *Stonycreek* in *Berlin, PA*.

- Meeting was called to order at **6:45 PM** by *Ricky*.

2012 Annual Meeting Minutes Review

- *Ricky* read the *Minutes* from the **2014 Annual Meeting** held at *Thunder Ridge*.
- *Bob Saunders* motioned to accept the *Minutes* from the **2014 Annual Meeting**. Motion was seconded by *Steve Edmondson* with all parties in favor.

Treasurer's Report

- Copies of the *Treasurer's Report* were distributed to everyone at the meeting.

Reports

- **2015 SCTP State Shoot**
 - *Ricky* gave a brief overview of the **2015 SCTP State Shoot** hosted by *Blue Ridge*.
 - **230+** SCTP shooters attended the event.
- **2015 Eastern Zone Shoot**
 - *Ricky* gave a brief review of the **2014 Eastern Zone Shoot** hosted by *Factoryville*.
 - Turnout was low with only **32** shooters in the *Prelim* and **45** shooters in the *Main Event*.
- **2015 Western Zone Shoot**

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- **Bob Saunders** gave a review of the **2014 Western Zone Shoot** hosted by **Castlewood**.
- **Bob** mentioned that the turnout was low with **45** entries in the **Main Event**.
- **2016 Zone & State Shoots**
 - Ricky reminder those present that the **2016 Eastern Zone** would be hosted by **Central Penn**, the **2016 Western Zone** hosted by **Castlewood**, and the **2016 State Shoot** hosted by **Stonycreek**.
 - **Roy Fritz** requested that **Stonycreek's 2016 State Shoot** application be modified to expand the **FITASC** event from **50 targets** at a cost of **\$65** to **100 targets** at a cost of **\$140**. **John Cummins** motioned that **Stonycreek** be allowed to make the change. Motion was seconded by **Rodger Becker** with all parties in favor.
 - **Roy Fritz** also took a moment to recognize and thank **Elite Shotguns** for their generous donation, **Scott Sipple** and **Hi-Grade** for the donated guns, **Kim Spohn** for donating tee-shirts, **Steve Edmondson** for donating diamond earrings, **Bob Zeigler** for donating bottled water, **Lincoln Traps**, and **Tom & Jean** of **Shooters Solutions** for donating shooting towels.

New Business

- There was a raffle drawing from all **Sub-Junior** and **Junior** entrants at the **State Shoot** for a **Beretta A300** donated by **Hi-Grade**. The winner of the drawing was **Eric Winey**.
- There was also another raffle from all the pre-paid entries for a **Benelli Nova** donated by **Hi-Grade** and **Scott Sipple** of **Benelli**. The winner of the drawing was **Ken Heese**.
- **Ricky** took a few moments to explain the questions on the ballot about proposed changes to the **PSCA By-Laws**.
- **Ricky** also explained some of the changes to the **State Shoot** guidelines, including...
 - Utilizing a points system in awarding of the **State Shoot**.
 - Awarding the **State Shoot** to a hosting club for two (2) consecutive years.
 - Making **Pump** and **Side-by-Side** events optional.
- **2017 Zone & State Shoots**
 - There were no applications submitted from clubs wishing to host the **2017 Zone Shoots**.
 - There were three (3) clubs that submitted applications to host the **2017 State Shoot: Buffer Creek, Castlewood** and **M&E**. Representatives from each of the three (3) clubs were given time at the meeting to address the audience and promote their bid to host the **2017 State Shoot**. Ballots were available during the **State Shoot** and the votes will be tallied at the conclusion of this year's **State Shoot**. The results of the voting will be available on the **PSCA** website.
 - After the presentations, there was a lengthy and heated discussion as to the eligibility of **M&E** in submitting an application to host the **2017 State Shoot**. The

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main objection being that the *M&E* application was accepted in violation of *Article XI* of the *PSCA By-Laws*. The proposed solutions ranged from discarding any votes cast for *M&E* to having all of the existing ballots discarded; removing *M&E* from the ballot and having the shooters recast their votes on Sunday. After several minutes of arguing with no definitive solution, *Ricky* stated that based on his knowledge of the *PSCA By-Laws* and past discussions among the *PSCA Board* on this matter (*i.e. clubs wishing to host a State Shoot without previously hosting a Zone or State Shoot*), he had accepted *M&E*'s application in good faith. *Ricky* further stated that he had also informed the *PSCA Board* of *M&E*'s application at the *PSCA* monthly meeting and had pointed out that *M&E* had not hosted a previous *Zone* or *State Shoot*, and there were no objections raised. With this in mind, *Ricky* asked for a motion that the application from *M&E*, as well as the results of the ballots, be accepted and considered valid. The motion was made by *Scott Hackman* and seconded by *John Cummins*. There were two (2) *NAY* votes with the majority being *YEA* votes.

- *Ricky* mentioned that based on the results of the voting, if the shooters voted to eliminate the *Zone Shoots*, he would contact the host clubs of the *2016 Zone Shoots*, giving them the option of cancelling their respective *2016 Zone Shoots*.
- *Shell Game Drawing*
 - There were *60* flats of 12 gauge ammunition to be given away to shooters based on their scores from the *Saturday* portion of the *Main Event*.
 - The *Shell Game* numbers drawn were *0, 3, and 8*.

Adjourn

- Motion to adjourn was made by *Rick Ott* and seconded by *Dave Defernelmont* with all parties present in favor.
- Meeting was adjourned at approximately *9:05 PM*.
