Call to Order:

- The meeting was called to order at 7:03 PM by *Ricky*

Previous Meeting Minutes:

- The *March* meeting Minutes were emailed to *Board* members prior to the meeting.
- After reviewing, *Steve* motioned to accept the *March* meeting Minutes. The motion was seconded by *Sandy* with all present in favor.

Treasurer's Report:

- Copies of the *Treasurer's Report* were emailed to *Board* members prior to the meeting. *Ricky* mentioned that unfortunately, *Andy* was unable to attend this evening's meeting.
- *Ricky* also informed those present that he had asked *Andy* to make a donation of \$100 on behalf of the PSCA to the *Red Brush Chapter of the Ruffed Grouse Society* in memory of *Scott Sipple*.
- *Wes* motioned to accept the *Treasurer's Report*. Motioned was seconded by *Eric* with all parties in favor.

Old Business:

- *Eric* gave an update on the *State Shoot*...
 - *Joe Scull* and *Rod Shyda* will be at *M&E* on *May 8th* to meet with *Eric* and at that time they will finalize the various courses for the *State Shoot*.
- *Ricky* mentioned that the remaining trophies for the *State Shoot Main* and *Prelim Events* have been ordered. However, he is still awaiting confirmation from the vendor on the *FITASC*, *Sub-Gauges*, *Pump*, and *SxS* trophies.
- *Eric* mentioned that *M&E* had received an over-shipment of shells from *Fiocchi* in their last shipment, so since *Wes* had not yet placed the order for the shells for the *Shell Game* at the *State Shoot*, the *PSCA* will purchase the over-stock from *M&E*. *Eric* will submit an invoice to the *PSCA* and *Ricky* will coordinate with *Andy* to get payment to *M&E*.

New Business:

- *Ricky* informed those present that he had received an application from *Rock Mountain* to host the *2020 State Shoot*. *Ricky* expressed that the only concern he had is that per the *State Shoot* application, the submitting club is required to have thrown at least *20,000* registered targets in the year prior to submitting its application, as well as the year in

which it submits the application. Per the NSCA website, *Rock Mountain* has thrown 18,500 registered targets last year (2016). With the application being for the 2020 *State Shoot* (3 years away), it was suggested that *Rock Mountain's* application can be held and accepted next year, allowing *Rock Mountain* to get their registered target count up for this year (2017) and next year (2018).

- *Jeff* also brought up the idea of going back to awarding the *State Shoot* for one (1) year instead of the current two (2) consecutive years. After some discussion, it was agreed that the awarding of the *State Shoot* to two (2) consecutive years had not had the expected results and it would be better to return to the awarding for one (1) year. *Ricky* will be working on updating the current *State Shoot* application and send it out to the *PSCA Board* in time for the next meeting for further discussion.

Schedule Next Meeting:

- Since the 3rd *Friday* of *May* is during the *NE Regional* at *M&M*, and the following *Friday* being the start of the *Memorial Day* weekend, it was decided to cancel the *May* meeting. The next meeting will be the *June* meeting, scheduled for the *Friday, June 16th 2017* at 7:00 *PM*
