 - ✓ The *PSCA* had sponsored the tee-shirts for the SCTP shooters at this year's *SCTP PA State Shoot*.

- ✓ \$200 of PSCA funds were used to purchase snacks for shooters at the SCTP State Shoot.
- ✓ *Clinton Dicks* of *Lawrence County* asked if the PSCA would be consider sponsoring the tee-shirts in *2019* when *Lawrence County* will be hosting the *SCTP PA State Shoot*. *Ricky* agreed that the *PSCA* would be open to sponsoring the tee-shirts.
